On behalf of the Hillsborough County Chiropractic Society, I would like to sincerely thank you in advance for your participation in, or any support you might be able to offer for this year's 11th annual charity golf tournament. OHHT provides a variety of services and items such as: bus passes, car rentals, meals and gasoline certificates, cell phones, and even entertainment coupons. Since the beginning of Operation Iraqi Freedom and Operation Enduring Freedom, the **James A. Haley Veteran's Hospital** has seen a marked increase in the number of patients referred for treatment. Their Spinal Cord Injury and Comprehensive Rehabilitation Units have treated some of the most severely injured service members involved in these two operations.
